



- a great writer who cannot be forgotten.





### 3. Oxford



In its reading rooms generations of many famous people have studied for a very long time including Nobel Prize winners,

British Prime Ministers and writers like Oscar Wilde J.R.R Tolkien and C.S Lewis.



Carfax Tower – The Carfax tower is all that remains of the 13<sup>th</sup> century St Martin's Church which was the official city church of Oxford from 1122.

The tower is 74 feet tall. It is possible to go to the top of the tower to enjoy an amazing view over the Oxford skyline.



Covered Market- It's centered in the middle of the city. It was built in the 1770's. The market's always been an attraction for visiting tourists. It provides a unique showcase of the best local food and drinks.



University of Oxford- University of Oxford is one of the best and most prestigious universities in the world. It's the oldest English-speaking university in the world! It grew really fast from 1167 when Henry II banned English students from attending the University of Paris. There are more than 25 000 students at Oxford, including 12 000 undergraduates and 13 000 postgraduates.
