Stonehenge was built in six stages between 3000 and 1520 years before the common era. The first monument was an early henge, built about 5000 years ago. Since 1986 Stonehenge has been a UNESCO world heritage site.

We had a lot of fun, and I can say it was the best holiday ever.




